Money Follows the Person states will begin reporting the number of people successfully transitioning to the community and related HCBS Quality Measures in September 2026 (specifically MLTSS/FFS LTSS-6, -7, and -8).

The Community Transition Dashboard helps states stay ahead of Access Rule and HCBS Quality Measures requirements by previewing results and addressing data quality issues early.
