
SERVICE #1: Policy decision support

Policy decision support (PDS) involves surfacing design, implementation, and process improvement to help states with program decision making. As a special-use case of PDS, Mathematica provides **value-based payment transformation services** to help states transitioning from a fee-for-service or managed-care delivery and payment system to payment and delivery system models that promote value among providers.

SERVICE #2: Monitoring

After a policy or program has been implemented, Mathematica offers monitoring services that help states oversee impacts of change in near real time. This offering supports monitoring for managed care organization contract compliance in the areas of access to care, utilization, and health care quality and outcomes monitoring, including intended and unintended consequences.
